REGULATION NO. 07/2017

**AMENDMENT AND SUPPLEMENTING OF THE REGULATION NO NO.03/2017 ON
THE INITIAL TRAINING**

Article 1
Purpose

The purpose of this Regulation is to amend and supplement the Regulation No. 03/2017 on Initial Training (in the following text: Regulation).

Article 2

Article 6 paragraph 4 of the basic Regulation, has been amended as following:

4. Judges and state prosecutors attend the practical training under the mentorship of a judge or state prosecutor working in the General Department. In case of insufficient number of judges or state prosecutors in the General Department, may also be assigned as mentor, judges or state prosecutors of the Serious Crime Department. If newly appointed judges are assigned to the Department of Administrative Affairs or the Department of Commercial affairs of the Basic Court, may be appointed as mentor, judges working in these departments.

Article 3

After Article 15 of basic Regulation, has been added a new Article 15/A as follows:

Article 15/A Test structure

1. Written exam consists of two (2) parts.
2. The first part of the test consists of questions with alternative response, the content of which is in accordance with Article 15, paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Basic Regulation.
3. The second part of the test contains a practical case that is selected from sub modules that have more than 5 training sessions excluding, the module: "Legislation and Additional Skills" where the test for this module contains only questions with alternative responses.

Article 4

Article 17 of the basic Regulation, after paragraph 85, added a new paragraph 9 as follows:

9. The part of the test with questions with alternative responses lasts 45 minutes, whereas part of practical case lasts 120 minutes.

Article 5

Article 19 of the basic Regulation, after paragraph 4, added a new paragraph 5 as follows:

5. The announcement of the final results is conducted through publication of the lists in the Academy's announcement board, the Academy's official web site and electronic post.

Article 6

Article 20 of the basic Regulation, has been supplemented with paragraph 3, 4, 5, and 6 as follows:

3. "The complaints of the participants for the test, are reviewed by the Appeals Committee, within not more than 10 days from the day the complaint deadline expires.
4. If the Appeals Committee finds that a breach of the rules on the organization or assessment of the test has occurred, it may:
 - 4.1 Correct technical errors and change the test result;
 - 4.2 requires reassessment of the test based on the recommendations of this Committee;
 - 4.3 requires repeat of the test for a particular part or for the whole test;

5. In case of a test repetition, the test is organized within 5 days from the decision of the Managing Board. In this case the test subject to the complainant must be re-drafted.
6. With regard to point 4.2 and 4.3, the Committee makes a recommendation to the Managing Board for decision."

Article 7
Entering into force

This Regulation enters into force upon the day of its approval by the Managing Board of the Academy of Justice.
